



The AutoCAD suite of applications includes AutoCAD LT (for licensed users), AutoCAD Architecture, and AutoCAD Mechanical. AutoCAD LT is the entry-level application, and focuses on drafting only. AutoCAD Architecture is a full-featured application for drafting and design. The tools and functionality of AutoCAD Architecture are similar to those of AutoCAD LT, but with improved usability. AutoCAD Architecture was first released in February 2008. AutoCAD Mechanical is a web-based application that allows users to create and publish customizable two-dimensional models using 3D models that were created using a 3D CAD application, such as AutoCAD LT or AutoCAD Architecture. First of all, it is important to understand what a drawing is. A drawing is a collection of objects, or parts, in a particular order. Each object can be modified individually by changing its shape, position, dimensions, and color. An object can also be given a name, so that it can be referred to by its name later.
